

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 10 JULY 2024

DELEGATING APPOINTING AUTHORITY AND AUTHORITY AUTHORISED TO CONCLUDE CONTRACTS OF EMPLOYMENT POWERS

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Article 1b of the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union (hereafter "Staff Regulations"), according to which the Staff Regulations and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union (hereafter "CEOS") shall apply to the staff of EPPO,

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (hereinafter referred to as "the EPPO Regulation")¹, and in particular Article 96(3) thereof,

Having regard to Article 2 of the Staff Regulations,

Having regard to Article 6 of the CEOS,

Whereas in accordance with the EPPO Regulation the powers conferred on the appointing authority by the Staff Regulations and the Conditions of Employment to conclude contracts of employment are exercised by the College;

Whereas the Commission Communication of 20 July 1995² lays down general guidelines for the division of competences on staff management between decentralized bodies and the Commission:

Whereas the Commission, by Decision of 6 November 2002³, established an Office for the Administration and Payment of Individual Entitlements ("PMO"), which can provide its services to other institutions;

Whereas the services the PMO provides to EPPO have been laid down in the Service-Level Agreement.

Has adopted this Decision:

Sole Article

The College of the EPPO hereby delegate to the Director of PMO the powers of the appointing authority, respectively the authority authorised to conclude contracts of employment in respect of its staff members⁴ with regard to the Articles of the Staff Regulations and the CEOS listed below. The Director of PMO shall sub-delegate these powers in accordance with Article 2(2) of the Staff Regulations and Article 6 of the Conditions of employment taking into account the internal organisation of the PMO.

The Delegation of powers is granted for the following Articles of the Staff Regulations and CEOS, grouped in accordance with the sections of Part II.2 of the Service Level Agreement.

This decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption.
