

DECISION OF THE COLLEGE OF THE EUROPEAN PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE OF 15 JANUARY 2025

AMENDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE EPPO'S STAFF COMMITTEE

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union ('CEOS') laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/681, and in particular Articles 9, 10a and 110(2) thereof, Article 1 of Annex II to the Staff Regulations and Article 7 of the CEOS,

Having regard to the Council Regulation (EU) 2017/1939 of 12 October 2017 implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('the EPPO'),¹ and in particular Article 96 thereof,

Having regard to the Communication C(2014) 6543 final of 26 September 2014 from Vice-President Šefčovič to the Commission on the guidelines on the implementation of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations with regard to the implementing rules applicable in the agencies, and in particular Point 2.B thereof,

Having regard to the agreement of the European Commission pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations given with the Decision C(2016) 3323 final of 27 May 2016,

Having consulted the Staff Committee;

Whereas:

1. The first EPPO Staff Committee formally commenced its mandate on 13 April 2022, and ever since, the EPPO headcount has doubled, thus increasing the space for representativeness of EPPO staff.

2. The growth in the EPPO staff members poses greater dedication demands to cover all Staff Committee duties and justify the need to modify the number of its full members.
3. This modification is in line with Point 2.B of the Communication C(2014) 6543 final of 26 September 2014 2014 from Vice-President Šefčovič and with the agreement of the European Commission pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations given with the Decision C(2016) 3323 final of 27 May 2016.

Has adopted this decision:

Article 1

Amendment

Article 3, paragraph 2, of the Decision 109/2021 of the College of 25 October 2021 setting up a Staff Committee, is amended as follows:

“2. The Committee shall consist of five full members.”

Article 2

Entry into force

This Decision shall enter into force on the day following that of its adoption.
