APPROVING A REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL REVENUE TO ON-
BOARD EUROPEAN DELEGATED PROSECUTORS FOR 2025

The College of the European Public Prosecutor's Office (EPPO),

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 1939/2017 of 12 October 2017¹ implementing enhanced cooperation on the establishment of the European Public Prosecutor's Office ('EPPO'), and in particular Article 92 thereof,

Whereas the EPPO needs additional financial resources in order to on-board additional European Delegated Prosecutors during 2025 to enable the EPPO to act in accordance with its mandate,

Has adopted the following decision:

Article 1

The College approves the request for additional revenue and expenditure to be submitted to the EU budgetary authority, as described in the Annex which forms an integral part of this Decision.

Article 2

This decision shall enter into force on the day following its adoption.

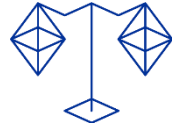

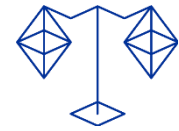

ANNEX: Request on additional revenue in the year 2025

The EPPO needs € 700,000 of additional resources to increase the number of European Delegated Prosecutors, gradually on boarding in 2025: 16 new European Delegated Prosecutors for Poland, 1 for Slovenia and 1 for Cyprus.
